CLUB REPORTS

Financial:

We have \$20,000 in checking. We also have nearly \$33,000 in CD and Money Market accounts.

We will have semiannual payments due to the Rotary International, Paul Harris, and Will Watt in January. The estimated total of these payments is \$12,000.

We also owe about \$5,000 to the Ferst Foundation for the golf tournament. However, there is still \$2,090 of outstanding golf tournament fees and sponsorships.

We have \$6,595.73 of other dues receivable, with only 7 members with unpaid invoices over 180 days.

Billing for the next quarter (January through March) will be posted in mid-January.
