PROGRAM REPORT

Garrett Williams, scout executive, Central Georgia Council, Boy Scouts of America

As scout executive, Williams serves over 66,000 youth in the 24-county Central Georgia Council.

He marked the 100th anniversary of Scouting, pointing out that no matter how times have changed, the values that Scouting stands for remain the same.

"We're in the business of building character," Williams said.

Those young people participate in Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, Venturing and Exploring. Another program, called Learning for Life, is a character education curriculum aimed at a school setting.

Williams said Scouting is alive and well in the Warner Robins area - there are 25 Scouting programs in the Robert L. Scott district here.
