Jeff McAfee, president, Joanna McAfee Childhood Cancer Foundation

McAfee returned to the club with an update on the foundation that bears his late daughter's name.

The Joanna McAfee Childhood Cancer Foundation is moving into a new office on Commercial Circle this month, and sales of the Foundation's auto tag "are really, really doing well," he said.

Currently there are upwards of 5,000 Joanna McAfee tags on Georgia vehicles. Some businesses are adopting the tags for their entire fleet.

The Foundation allocates most of its revenue toward research grants. In just three years, McAfee said, the group has raised \$436,000.
