Paul Bankson introduced Tufts, who is an elder at Houston Lake Presbyterian Church and a retiree of the U.S. Air Force. Tufts spoke on "Leaders in the Rough" - a set of principles he has acquired through the years that are effective tools at honing one's leadership skills.

Tufts credited the book "On Strategy: A Critical Analysis of the Vietnam War" by Harry Summers as the first text to make an impression on him. From that point on, Tufts said, he became "a student of leadership," with the desire to emulate good leaders.

He explained that a leader was, in simplest terms, "someone taking someone somewhere."

Tufts went on to outline what he called the four dimensions of leadership - yourself, you and your job, you and your boss, and you and your team.

"People want to be led by good leaders," he said.
