Our own Mayor Shaheen filled in at the last minute and gave an impromptu "state of the city" chat.

After three and an half months in office, the mayor praised those who went before him, as well as the city's employees, saying they have exceeded his expectations.

"Our city has the most professional employees I've ever seen," he said, before expressing admiration for fellow members of city council, who are "making me a better person and a better mayor."

Shaheen said among his top priorities currently is finding an entrepreneur who wants to be a contract manager of the U.S. Post Office on North Davis Drive, as well as determining where the city's proposed new law enforcement center will be located.

He said he is forging tighter bonds with Perry and Centerville, seeing strength in numbers when it comes to supporting the continued military value of Robins Air Force Base or encouraging lawmakers to extend a proposed rail system from Atlanta to Warner Robins.
