Our own Marsha Priest Buzzell gave us a preview of several upcoming events which will result in a massive influx of visitors to Houston County between July and October. These events including regional Little League playoffs, the Georgia Golden Olympics, and a senior bowling tournament. She focused her talk, however, on the Special Olympics Georgia Games.

The Warner Robins Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB) competed against Savannah, Columbus and Augusta to host the games for the next three years. Warner Robins got the nod, Buzzell said, because of the "legendary" strength of community support.

The Special Olympics Georgia Games will take place at Gold Cup Bowling Center and locations on Robins Air Force Base, Aug. 20-22. The Museum of Aviation will host a dance on the final day of the games. Approximately 1,000 participants and family members are expected to be here for the games.
