PROGRAM REPORT

George Hartwig, **chief assistant district attorney,** **Houston Judicial Circuit**

George Hartwig entered public service 32 years ago as a Broward County (Fla.) police officer at the age of 19, in a career that led him to the legal profession and ... back to public service.

Everywhere his career has taken him has prepared him for his current work in the Houston Judicial Circuit. After a stint as an undercover drug agent in South Florida, he came to Middle Georgia to attend Mercer's Walter F. George School of Law. After earning his degree he worked in private practice as a trial lawyer for 10 years - seven of which leading his own firm.

But at 42, he walked away from the more-lucrative career path and back into public service. Houston DA Kelly Burke hired Hartwig nine years ago as a prosecutor.

Hartwig recently took the chief assistant DA post by promotion - he was previously the senior assistant DA in charge of drug prosecutions. He said he currently responsible for most of the day-to-day operation of the office, and handles major cases.
