PROGRAM REPORT

May 12, 2009

**Tommy Stalnaker,
director of Public Works,
Houston County Government**

Stalnaker returned to give us an update on the various government projects funded via the 2001 and 2006 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Taxes (SPLOSTs). These 1 percent taxes authorized by voters are funding numerous capital improvements around the county.

Most of these improvements are in the form of road widenings, and the most visible of which are improvements to Carl Vinson Parkway and Houston Lake Road.

Stalnaker also spoke about what's new in various county departments, including a new methane gas capturing mechanism that will be implemented at the county landfill, most likely through a contract with Flint Energies.
