PROGRAM REPORT

**Jennifer Colvin, Southern Region director,
Little League Baseball and Softball,
with Morgan Law, Jay Flesher and Marsha
Buzzell**

This "panel program" covered the new Little League Southeast Region Headquarters being constructed off Snellgrove Drive.

Morgan Law, executive director of the Houston County Development Authority, outlined the process leading up to the selection of Warner Robins as the site for the new region headquarters.

Then Colvin, who relocated from Little League's former region HQ in St. Petersburg, Fla., talked about what her job entails. She said the region office supports Little League in eight states, and she described her job as being one of customer service and adult education.

"I am responsible for how we educate adult volunteers, but also the positive impact we can have on young people involved in the tournaments," Colvin said.

Flesher discussed the challenges construction crews have faced in preparing the 28-acre tract for use as a ballfield and offices. He said workers excavated over 23 feet of dirt from the field and built up the road, parking lot and stadium. As of last Tuesday, Flesher said they were "99 percent done" with the project.

Buzzell said the expected economic impact is \$1,747,500, with 8,000 attending.

"These games could become a major brand for the city of Warner Robins," she said.

A dedication is slated for 10:30 a.m. Saturday, June 12.
