## PROGRAM REPORT

June 23, 2009

## Warner Robins Housing Authority

Oscar Mason, director of Asset Management for the Warner Robins Housing Authority, led a presentation and overview of the authority's mission and facilities.

Other employees on hand for the presentation were Gloria Smith, executive assistant; Nicole Inabet, procurement manager; and Toya Wilson and Clara Braswell, property managers. Executive Director Sheryl Frazier was ill and could not be present.

Mason explained that the authority is governed by a six-member board appointed by the mayor. These are unpaid policymakers.

The authority is regulated by the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which funds the authority's payroll as well. The authority's annual budget is dominated by the HUD contribution - \$2.5 million - but also includes about \$800,000 in capital funds and \$900,000 in federal stimulus money.

Despite its name, the authority operates not only 426 housing units in the city of Warner Robins, but also 40 units in unincorporated Houston County.

The Boys & Girls Club is located at T.J. Calhoun Homes, and the Meals on Wheels program operates out of Kemp Harrison Homes, which is home to primarily elderly and disabled residents.
