## **Dr. David Bell, president, Macon State College**

Bell explained that he has been leading Macon State College to adhere to what he sees as the institution's single mission.

"I think the purpose of the college is to make a substantial contribution to changing the competitive environment of central Georgia," he said.

Bell noted that 85-95 percent of MSC graduates remain in the area - and that is the type of student the college is seeking to recruit. He said keeping these students in the area - and the impact they have as a result - is essentially more significant than merely the economic impact of the college on the area.

He also announced that the college was enacting higher admission standards this fall, as part of an effort to focus energy on students who can achieve, rather than those who require remediation.

Long a commuter college, MSC now offers student housing, to foster a "warmer, more nurturing learning environment," Bell said.
