ROTARY E-CLUB OF THE WEEK

Did you know there are several Rotary E-Clubs? This is the latest in a series spotlighting these alternate clubs you can visit, virtually.

The Rotary E-Club of Verkkorotary.fi, District 1420, is based in Finland, but most of their site is translated into English (click "In English" on the left menu when you load the page). The club has weekly online meetings, usually on Tuesdays at 9 p.m. Finnish time. These meetings are recorded.

On the first Tuesday of the month Verkkorotary has a normal "terra meeting," usually starting at 6 p.m. Finnish time. The club tries to broadcast the terra meetings on the Net.

In addition, Verkkorotary organizes international meetings every second month. There is an internal Club Portal, which provides current information about Finland and Rotary. It also serves as the basis for discussions (small talk and serious) on the Net and as a depository of all club information and documentation.
