Richard Azbell detailed the "Be the Church" outreach conducted annually by the Warner Robins First Assembly of God congregation.

The mission of the outreach is to demonstrate the love of Jesus Christ to unchurched members of the community. To do this, the congregation forgoes the Sunday morning ministries, and participates in myriad acts of kindness and service - everything from washing cars and pumping gasoline to providing meals and laundry money.

All of these activities take place away from the Watson Boulevard campus of the church.

"We feel the need to reach out of the church building," Azbell said. "So we go out when other people are in church to find people who don't attend."

This year there will be 40 activities going on at once on the morning of Aug. 8, with a focus on children returning to school the next day. So the Be the Church volunteers will be giving away 300 backpacks full of school supplies, as well as giving free haircuts to youngsters. Other activities will include litter collection at Wellston Trail, and vision and blood pressure screenings.

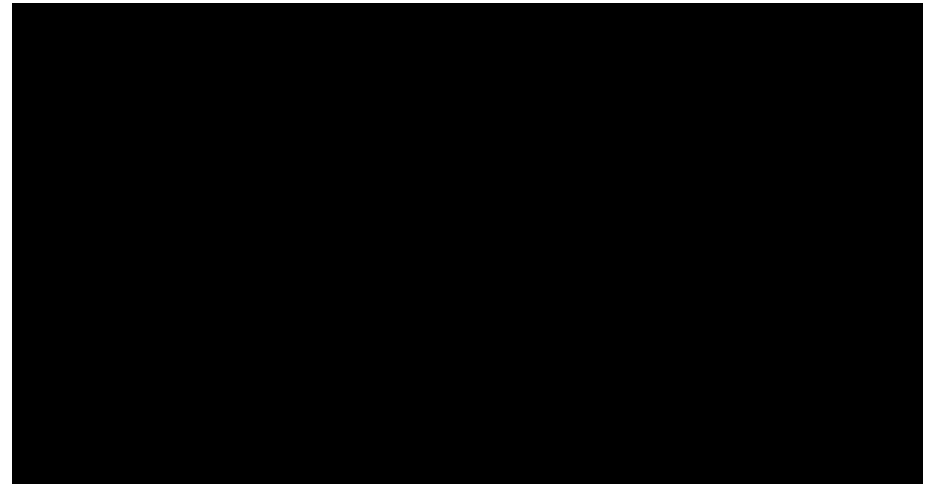
